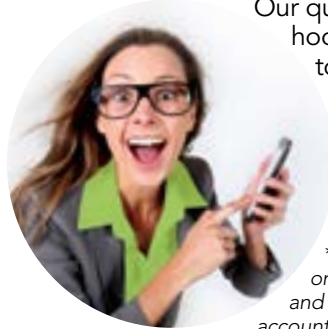

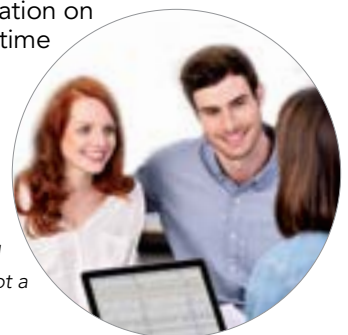

ANNUAL MEETING

The 2016 Annual Meeting will be held at the Credit Union headquarters located at 2100 Executive Hills Boulevard, Auburn Hills, Michigan on Wednesday, March 23, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. The Board of Directors Nominating Committee has submitted the names of members to fill the four Board positions: Gregory Melega, Pat Shaffer, John Schulte and Brian Zabowski.

Gregory Melega, a graduate of John Carroll University, is in Global Capital Management for General Motors Global Product Development Finance Staff, located at the Warren Technical Center. He has been a member of the credit union since 1982. Mr. Melega served as a Supervisory Committee member from 1992 until 1994. He was then elected to the Board of Directors where he currently serves.

Patrick Shaffer is a graduate of Central Michigan University with a Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration. He worked for GM for 34 years and retired in 2009. He then worked for Xerox from 2010 through 2014. He has been a member of the credit union since 1984. Mr. Shaffer served as a Supervisory Committee member from 1991-1994. He was then elected to the Board of Directors where he currently serves.

John Schulte attended Walsh College and received his Real Estate Alumni of Michigan certification from the University of Michigan. Mr. Schulte has been a member of the credit union in excess of 40 years and served on the Supervisory Committee in 1987. He was elected to the Board of Directors in 1988. Mr. Schulte has been very active in the credit union movement, having received multiple awards through the CUNA Volunteer Achievement Program. He remains active in the local community as a Realtor and Real Estate Consultant.

Brian Zabowski served in the United States Air Force from 1968-1972. After returning to civilian life, he received a Bachelor of Science Degree from Lawrence Technological University in the field of Industrial Management. He has been a member of the credit union since 1975. Mr. Zabowski was a member of the Supervisory Committee from 2001-2005 when he was elected to the Board of Directors where he currently serves.

Members of good standing who wish to be placed on the list of candidates for board positions may do so by petition. Official petitions are available by contacting the corporate office of the Credit Union CEO at (248) 322-9800, ext. 1001. The bylaws require that the signatures of at least 500 members in good standing be obtained. Biographical information, qualifications, and a signed certificate from the nominee stating that they are agreeable to nomination, and will serve if elected must accompany the petition. The Board serves without compensation and represents all members. The filing deadline for petitions is 5:00 p.m. – December 4, 2015. A mail ballot election will be held if the number of nominees exceeds the positions available. Send nominations to the Credit Union headquarters, to the attention of the Nominating Committee, 2100 Executive Hills Boulevard, Auburn Hills, Michigan. The results of the election of board members will be announced at the Annual Board Meeting, which will be held at the Credit Union headquarters. According to the bylaws, if only one person is nominated for each director's position, that person will be elected by acclamation.

in Clio, Fenton, Flint, Grand Blanc, Marysville, and Vassar for their commitment to raise the necessary dollars to help local area neighbors. The contributions raised included \$9,064.80, plus 35 pounds of canned food. This equates to 81,618 pounds of food, which will provide 54,412 meals for neighbors in our communities who are served by the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan through local community food centers, food pantries, etc. Genisys Credit Union was the overall first place winner among the other area credit unions in the competition bringing in the most contributions to help local communities.



Genisys inspires art in local areas with sponsoring five community art action projects. The Cascado Art Action Experience is an interactive mural-making process for adults and children of all ages. The Art Action Experience participated at the Metro Detroit Youth Day event in July, the Montrose Blueberry Festival and Dragon on the Lake in August, and the Art & Apples Festival in September. The final project location is to be determined. These experiences bring communities together in a fun artistic way to create a colorful scene representing the theme of the event. Attendees of all ages used their various abilities to design and color the mural. Genisys plans to donate the final mural of the art project back to each community.
