

2023 *Community Pride Scholarship Application*

In partnership with Genisys Credit Union and the Oxford Chamber of Commerce

Up to four (4) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to Oxford High School seniors in an academic year.

Criteria:

- Applicants must be a graduating Oxford High School senior with a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.
- Students may attend any college, university, trade school, or employer-sponsored skilled trade apprenticeship program and choose any course of study as a full time student.
- Applicants must submit an essay, artwork, video, or music, etc. explaining “What does the Oxford community mean to you?”
- One (1) letter of recommendation, a page or less in length, from a non-family member detailing why you would be a good choice for the Community Pride Scholarship. Letter can be from a teacher, coach, school administrator, or any other adult over the age of 21.
- Genisys Credit Union and Oxford Chamber of Commerce employees, contract employees, or board members, their immediate relatives, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews are not eligible to apply.
- Application must be received by close of business on **Friday, April 14, 2023.**

All complete applications will be reviewed by members of the Community Pride Scholarship Committee and awards will be determined in a fair and consistent manner. Scholarships will be awarded by May 1st, 2023. The scholarship check will be made payable to the educational institution. Checks will not be made payable to the student.

The following documents need to be submitted with your application:

- Letter of acceptance as a full-time student to an accredited institution: university, community college, trade school, vocational school, or employer-sponsored skilled trade apprenticeship program
- One (1) letter of recommendation, a page or less in length, from a non-family member detailing why you would be a good choice for the Community Pride Scholarship. Letter can be from a teacher, coach, school administrator, or any other adult over the age of 21.
- An essay, artwork, video, or music, etc. explaining “What does the Oxford community mean to you?”
